Guidelines for the \$600 Emerald Scholarship is as follows:

- A member in good standing must submit candidate's application - *dues must be paid by March 31st of current year.*
- Candidate's representative must be a member for the last 2 calendar years and must have attended a minimum of 4 meetings each year. (*Attendance Sign-In is required at the monthly Membership meetings.*)
- Candidates are required to submit a short bio (at least 150 words) explaining who they are and how they are related to the member of the organization. Include a history of participation in events that promote "Irish Culture"* and/or outline Community Service activities during Middle School and High School (minimum of 10 hrs.) The bio of the scholarship recipients will be printed in the May newsletter.
- Candidates and members of their family are required to help at the annual Feis held in May.
- The scholarships will be awarded at the April General Membership meeting. *If there are more than six candidates there will be a drawing and only 6 will be chosen.*
- Candidate must be represented at the April drawing by herself/himself or the member/representative listed on the application form.
- The proceeds of the scholarship will be paid upon successful completion of the 1st semester and submission of an "official raised stamped" document from the college, university or approved business or trade school to the scholarship administrator.
- Completed application must be received by the Scholarship Administrator, Jim Scully at or before the March meeting.

*Gaelic football, hurling, Irish step dancing, musical instrument or other Irish traditional activity.
